

## Notice of Office of Tasmanian Economic Regulator Fees for 2024-25

The *Fee Units Act 1997* requires the Office of the Tasmanian Economic Regulator to publish the value of its fees on its website from 1 July 2024 to 30 June 2025. The Fee Unit Value for 2024-25 is \$1.87 per unit, an increase of \$0.09 from the 2023-24 Fee Unit Value of \$1.78.

The Office of the Tasmanian Economic Regulator charges two fees: making a competitive neutrality complaint under section 49(c) of the *Economic Regulator Act 2009* and applying for an electricity licence under regulation 18 of the *Electricity Supply Industry Regulations 2018*.

The fees for 2024-25 are listed below.

### *Competitive neutrality fees*
