

Notice of Intention to conduct a Regulated Feed-in Tariff Rate Determination Pricing Investigation

The 2022 Regulated Feed-in Tariff Rate Determination expires on 30 June 2025 and the *Electricity Supply Industry (Pricing and Related Matters) Regulations 2023* require the Tasmanian Economic Regulator to conduct a pricing investigation before making a new determination.

The determination will set the minimum rate authorised electricity retailers are to pay standard feed-in tariff customers for electricity exported to the electricity grid.

The objective of the pricing investigation is to gather information to enable the Regulator to make the determination.

The Regulator will publish a draft report and draft determination on the Regulator's website (<https://www.economicregulator.tas.gov.au/electricity/pricing/feed-in-tariffs>) by 21 February 2025.

Written submissions on the draft determination and on the issues discussed in the draft report can be made to the Regulator during a consultation period ending on 21 March 2025.

The investigation final report will be released and the determination will be made in May 2025. The determination will apply from 1 July 2025.
