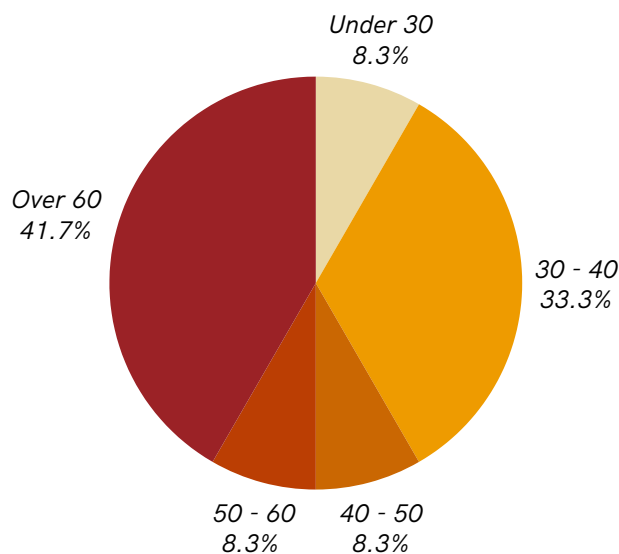

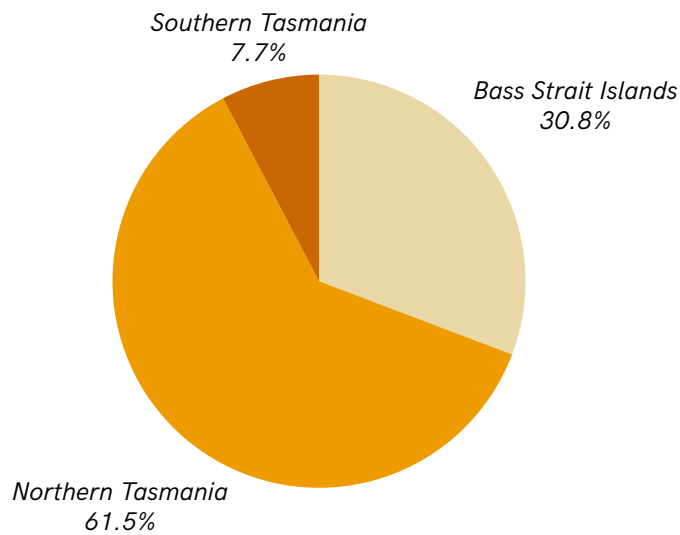
Gender representation

Other issues facing the Community are of more importance.

Participants chose not to answer the survey questions provided.

Statements provided by members of the workshop.

Water is life. Life is Water. Always was. Always will be.

- Tasmanian Aboriginal people should not be charged for using water - although we recognise the difficulty this would present while self-identifying processes are in place.
- Alternatively, charges should be income tested to support lower socio-economic families across Tasmania.
- Increased charges should be applied to corporates and industry.
- Strict consequences and punishments should be applied to water pollution events.
- Remove fluoride from the water supply.
- Priority should be placed on improving the ageing infrastructure and waste treatments to avoid cross-contamination and pollution events.
- Concern for the impact experienced by our cultural resources and Aboriginal heritage on infrastructure installation. More consultation on site-specific infrastructure should be implemented.
- Concern about climate change impacts and future water preservation for the islands in particular (had to ship bottled water to Truwana this year).

- Concerns about water wastage in general.
