BACKGROUND

Pursuant to the *Electricity Supply Industry Act 1995* (the Act), the Regulator is responsible for administering the Tasmanian licensing system for electricity entities (excluding retailer authorisations on mainland Tasmania).

AETV Pty Ltd (ACN 123 391 613), formerly Aurora Energy (Tamar Valley) Pty Ltd is the holder of an electricity generation licence that is due to expire on 11 July 2017. The Regulator received a written request from AETV (Hydro Tasmania) on 14 February 2017, applying for the renewal of its licence.

CONSIDERATION OF RENEWAL OF LICENCE

Under the Act, the Regulator may only issue an electricity generation licence if satisfied that the applicant is a suitable person to hold the licence, and the generating plant will generate electricity of the appropriate quality for the relevant transmission system or distribution network.


In considering whether to renew the AETV Pty Ltd generation licence, the Regulator takes into account the same considerations. From the information provided periodically by AETV Pty Ltd as part of its licensee obligations, the Regulator is satisfied that AETV Pty Ltd still meets the requirements of the Act to hold the generation licence.

REGULATOR'S DECISION

After considering AETV's application for renewal, the Regulator is satisfied that the renewal of its electricity generation licence is consistent with the Act.

The Regulator decides to renew the electricity generation licence of AETV Pty Ltd for a further 10 years **effective on 12 July 2017**.
