1. INFORMATION FOR APPLICANTS

1.1 Application

An application for a licence under the *Gas Industry Act 2019* (the Act) must be made to the *Regulator* in a form approved by the *Regulator*. This form is the *approved form* and provides the template for a statement addressing the licence requirements in accordance with section 21 of the Act.

1.2 Use of this form

Words in this form:

- importing the singular include the plural and vice versa; and
- appearing italicised in bold type have the meaning ascribed to them in the Act.

Licence applicants must provide all information for the type of licence sought, including enclosing additional information where required. Additional lines can be added to the form if more space is required to provide the requested information. Please include all locations where the *gas activity* will be undertaken. Failure to provide all requested information may delay the assessment of the application.

The *Regulator* may require applicants who have submitted a completed application to provide further information or to clarify the information provided.

It is an offence under the Act for a person to knowingly give false or misleading information, whether by reason of the inclusion or omission of any particular, to the *Regulator* (section 96).

1.3 Type of licence requested

This form is to be completed by a person making an application to the *Regulator* to authorise the carrying out of a *gas activity* by issuing one or more of the following licences:

- 1. *Gas infrastructure licence*: authorises the *gas activity* of construction, installation, maintenance, alteration and operation of *gas infrastructure* (*distribution system* or *transmission pipeline*).
- 2. Gas retail licence: authorises the gas activity of selling of gas by retail.

Activities carried out under a licence may be at one or more locations, and may consist of a combination of different gas activities. If both a *gas retail licence* and *gas infrastructure licence* are applied for and granted, separate licences will be issued.

If you are unsure whether you require a licence under the Act, you should seek independent advice.

1.4 Licence fees

Application fee

The completed application form must be accompanied by an application fee of 1,270 fee units for a *gas infrastructure licence*, or 635 fee units for a *gas retail licence*. The value of a fee unit is set by the Government each year. The values are available from the Department of Treasury and Finance website.

1.5 Conditions of a licence

Statutory licence conditions are provided for in Section 30 of the Act. The licence may include any other conditions determined by the *Regulator* for the purposes of the Act.

1.6 Administrative review and appeal against decision

Pursuant to the Act, a licence applicant may apply to the *Regulator* for the administrative review of a decision to grant or refuse to grant an application. A licence applicant who is dissatisfied with the decision of the *Regulator* on administrative review may appeal against the decision to the Minister.

1.7 Consultation and confidentiality

The *Regulator* is required to give notice of an application for the grant of a licence in the Gazette, or in such other manner as the *Regulator* considers appropriate, at least 30 *business days* before the application is determined by the *Regulator*. Please note that the application may be the subject of consultation and/or published on the website at www.economicregulator.tas.gov.au.

The *Regulator* must preserve the confidentiality of information gained in the course of administering the Act that could affect the competitive position of a gas entity or other person, or is commercially sensitive for some other reason. The licence applicant may request that information provided to the *Regulator* be treated as confidential. Material subject to such a request must be clearly identified.
