INTEREST ON OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

Southern Water will not charge interest or fees on overdue accounts except in accordance with the provisions of the *Tasmanian Water and Sewerage Industry Customer Service Code*.

Where interest is to be charged, or calculated, for a refund on overcharged amounts, as interest earned on a security deposit paid or for failure to pay a debt due, it will be calculated at the bank bill *rate*.

Interest will accrue daily and will be capitalised (if not paid or refunded) every 90 days.

A \$5.00 fee for failure to pay a debt may be charged, unless:

- a. the account balance is less than \$50; or
- b. you are eligible for a concession; or
- c. you pay the overdue amount within five days of the due date; or
- d. you have contacted us prior to the fifth day after the due date and have been offered a flexible payment plan.
